Teens engaged in high-risk behavior

Our goal is for young people in this community to stay out of trouble.

Young people make smart choices about their lives

Kids don't become pregnant

Rate of Teen Pregnancy

Rate of Teen Births

In 1990, 24 per 1000 girls became pregnant.

After 4 years, 75% reduction in pregnancies (7 per 1000)

In 1995, 15.7 pregnancies per 1000 teen girls

Survey showed that girls sexually active but not using birth control.

Reduce teen pregnancy rate by 50% in the next 4 years

Be among the best counties in the state

Many girls had older partners.

Kids don't have anything to do after school.

The health department puts kids on waiting list for appointments

Parents don't know how to talk to their kids about sex.

Home visiting for teen parents

Mentoring program

Active prosecution of adult sex offenders

Form a teen pregnancy collaborative

Wait for appointments reduced to 48 hours

Prosecution rate for adult offenders higher after two years
